


OECD unemployment rate falls to 7.0% in February 2015

The **OECD** unemployment rate fell by 0.1 percentage point to 7.0% in February 2015, with a cumulative decline of 1.1 percentage points since the peak reached in January 2013. Across the OECD area, 42.9 million people were unemployed, 6 million less than in January 2013.

In the **euro area**, the unemployment rate fell by 0.1 percentage point, to 11.3% in February, 0.8 percentage point below the peak recorded in April 2013. Increases in unemployment rates were recorded only in **Finland, Portugal and Italy**.

The unemployment rate in February also fell in the **United States** (by 0.2 percentage point, to 5.5%, its lowest level since May 2008) and in **Japan** (by 0.1 percentage point to 3.5%) but increased in **Canada** (by 0.2 percentage point, to 6.8%). More recent data referring to March 2015 show that the unemployment rate was stable in the **United States** and in **Canada**.

Since the peak of January 2013, the OECD unemployment rate has declined by 1.1 percentage points for both **women** (to 7.1%) and **men** (to 7.0%), and by 2.5 percentage points for **youth** (among 15-24 year-olds), to 14.3% in February 2015, its lowest level since November 2008. Youth unemployment remains however exceptionally high in several euro area countries such as **Greece** (51.2% in December, the latest month available), **Italy** (42.6%), **Portugal** (35.0%) and **Spain** (50.7%).
